MEMBERSHIP

Members of HKFC may apply to become members of the Golf Society. Membership forms can be obtained from the Club Reception.

ANNUAL SUBSCRIPTION

As or when they are admitted, Members of the Golf Society are required to pay an annual non-refundable subscription. Members are reminded that Golf Society memberships are automatically renewed in January each year and Member's accounts are billed in the same month. Please notify the Club before 15 January each year if you no longer wish to continue to be a member. Otherwise your account will be debited accordingly with the annual subscription which will not be refundable thereafter.

USE OF PLAYING DEBENTURES AT TWO GOLF CLUBS

Golf Society Members can apply for playing debentures at Macau Golf & Country Club and Lotus Hill Golf Resort. Application forms are available at Club Reception or on Golf Society Website: www.hkfcgolf.com.hk. Members must observe byelaws, rules and guidelines promulgated by the two golf resorts whilst playing thereat. These byelaws, rules and guidelines can be found on the Website.

RENTAL OF SETS OF GOLF CLUBS

The Golf Society has 8 sets of golf clubs stored at Macau Golf & Country Club and 4 sets stored at Lotus Hill Golf Resort. Members and their guests may rent them at \$50 per set per day on a first come first served basis. When booking a playing debenture at either golf course, please indicate which set(s) you wish to rent on the respective booking form, which contains brief details of the sets and how these sets are allocated. Members are asked to maintain the clubs in good order and check that they are intact both before after playing. Any damage or loss must be reported to the Club without delay.

PARTICIPATION IN GOLF EVENTS

In general, two golf events at various golf resorts are organised each month. A tentative schedule of golf events has been uploaded on the Website and posted on Golf Society notice boards. The schedule is updated as and when necessary. When participating in such events, members must observe byelaws, rules and guidelines promulgated by the golf courses and facilities they are using as well as the Society's bye laws, rules and guidelines.

Members are advised of upcoming events through e-mail and they can check them out on Golf Society notice boards. Those members who wish to receive such e-notifications should provide their e-mail address to Golf Society through Club Reception if they have not yet done so and should inform Club Reception whenever they change their email address.
